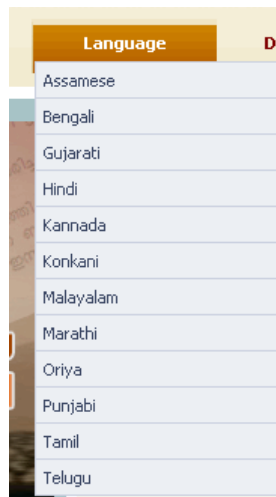
a. Open your Internet Browser



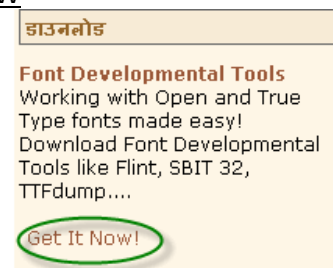
b. Type 'www.bhashaindia.com' in the address bar



c. Click on Language and select Language to download



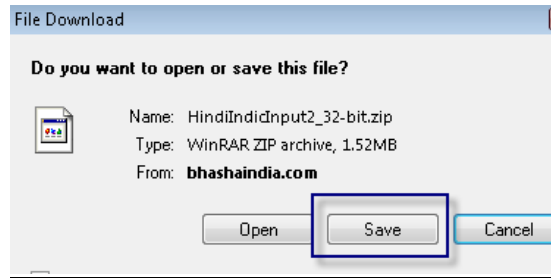
d. Click on Get It Now



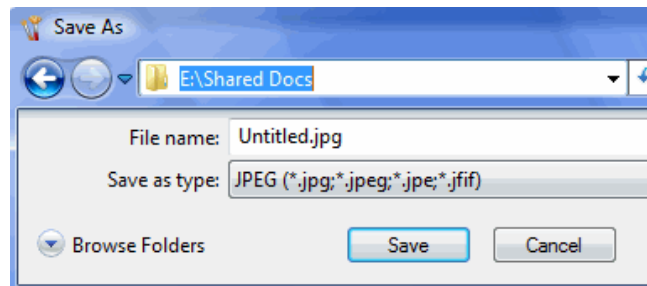
e. Select the Operating system and download language accordingly

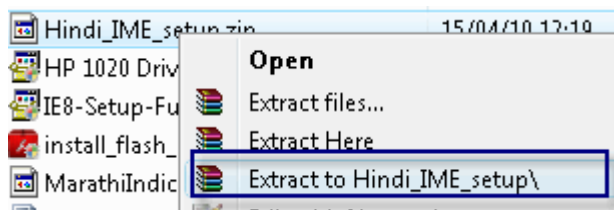
f. Click on Save



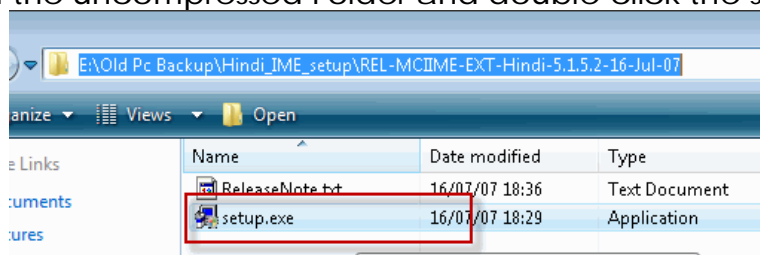
g. Select proper Destination to save



h. Right - Click the download Compressed Folder and select Extract to (Folder Name)

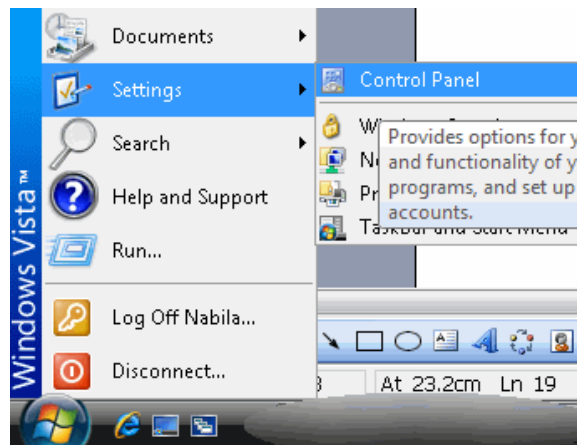


i. Open the uncompressed Folder and double-click the setup.exe

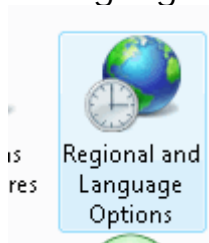


j. Click Next whenever it asks

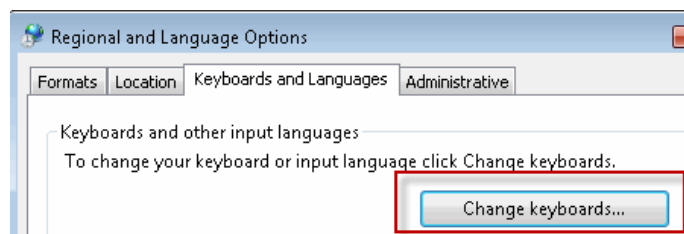
k. Go to Start and open Control Panel



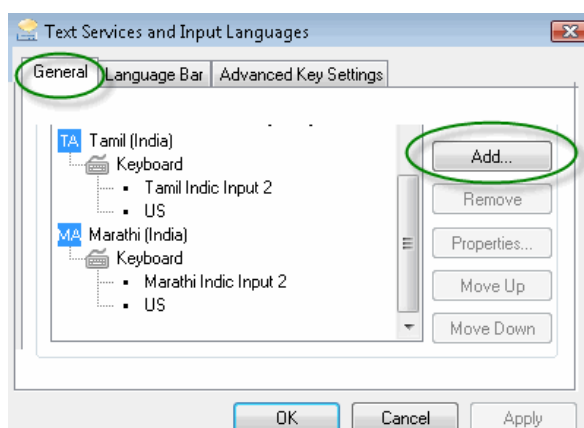
l. Open Regional and Language Option



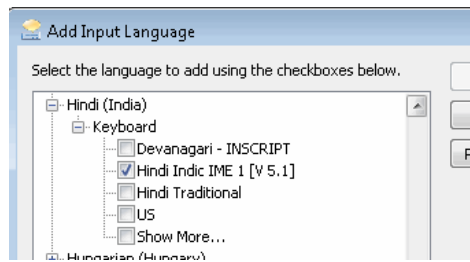
m. Go to Keyboards and Languages and click on Change Keyboards... option



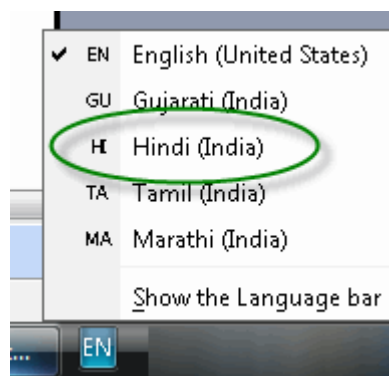
n. In General Tab, click on Add button
